#### What is a UA Rich Mountain Ambassador?

These Ambassadors are student spokespersons for the college. An ambassador is another avenue to help the recruitment and retention process. Under the supervision of the Recruiter, the ambassadors will help out with campus events, give tours of the campus, work in the admissions office, and attend recruitment activities off campus. An ambassador must have attended one of UA Rich Mountain's seven service area schools (Acorn, Caddo Hills, Cossatot River, Mena, Mt. Ida, Oden, or Waldron) or be a nontraditional student. Home school graduates from Scott, Polk and Montgomery counties are also welcome to apply!

Ambassadors may also be called upon to help with the interview process of future Ambassadors. Ambassadors must excel in their academics, display campus pride, and possess great communication skills.

# **Job Requirements**

- Attend & Assist with 1 Student Orientation Session per Semester
- Assist with 1 day of Pre-Registration & Registration per Semester
  - Assist with Junior & Senior Day activities
  - Attend 1 event per semester other than Junior & Senior Day
    - Work 1 hour per week in the Admission's Office
      - Give 5 Campus Tours per Semester
- Conduct 1 Volunteer/Non Profit Activity as a group each semester
  - Attend 1 Day Training in August

## **Academic Requirements**

- Maintain a 2.5 GPA
- Full Time Student (12 credit hours/semester)
- Graduate of 1 UA Rich Mountain's Service Area Schools, home schools, and/or Non-Traditional Student

#### **Pay**

- Book Stipend to UA Rich Mountain's Bookstore/Grab N Go
  - 2 Ambassador Shirts
  - Ambassador Name Tag
  - Christmas & Graduation Luncheon

(Of course free food at any campus event in which you assist)

#### **Selection Process**

To be an Ambassador, one must complete the application and meet the requirements previously mentioned. Once the application has been received and reviewed, students will undergo group interviews with Faculty and Staff. The interview process will consist of questions based upon academics, communication, campus pride, extracurricular activities, and asked to describe your favorite event at UA Rich Mountain. The Ambassadors for the next year will be announced at the Honors Assembly.
