The Kids' College staff is looking forward to offering a program of enrichment and fun for elementary students who will be **entering 1—5 grades** in the fall. The curriculum has been developed to offer a variety of courses for introduction and enhancement. With parents' and students' support and cooperation, we know that this will be a meaningful experience for all involved.

Kids' College will last four days. The dates are **July 11—14**. Priority Registration deadline is **June 9**. Additional registrations will be accepted on a space available basis until 8:00 a.m. July 11.
